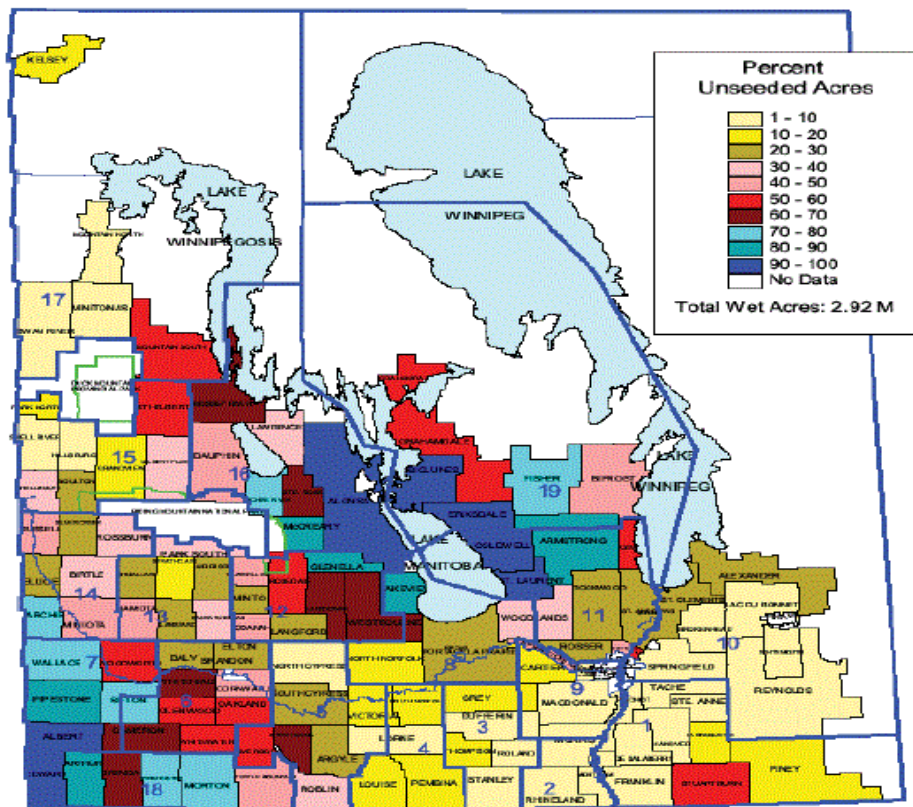

Percent Unseeded Acres Due to Excess Moisture 2011

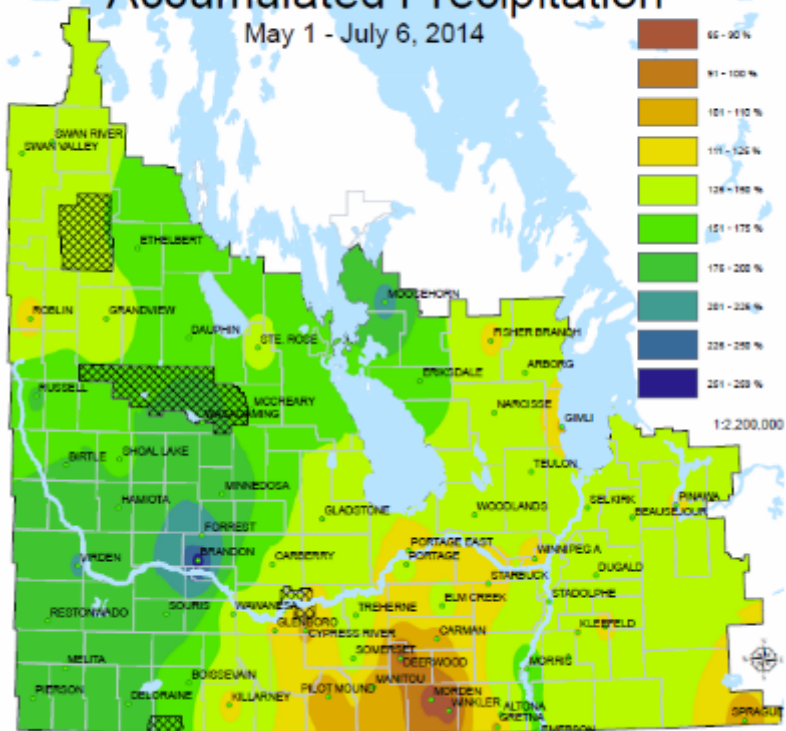


■ Relative to Total Insurable Acres - As of July 22, 2011

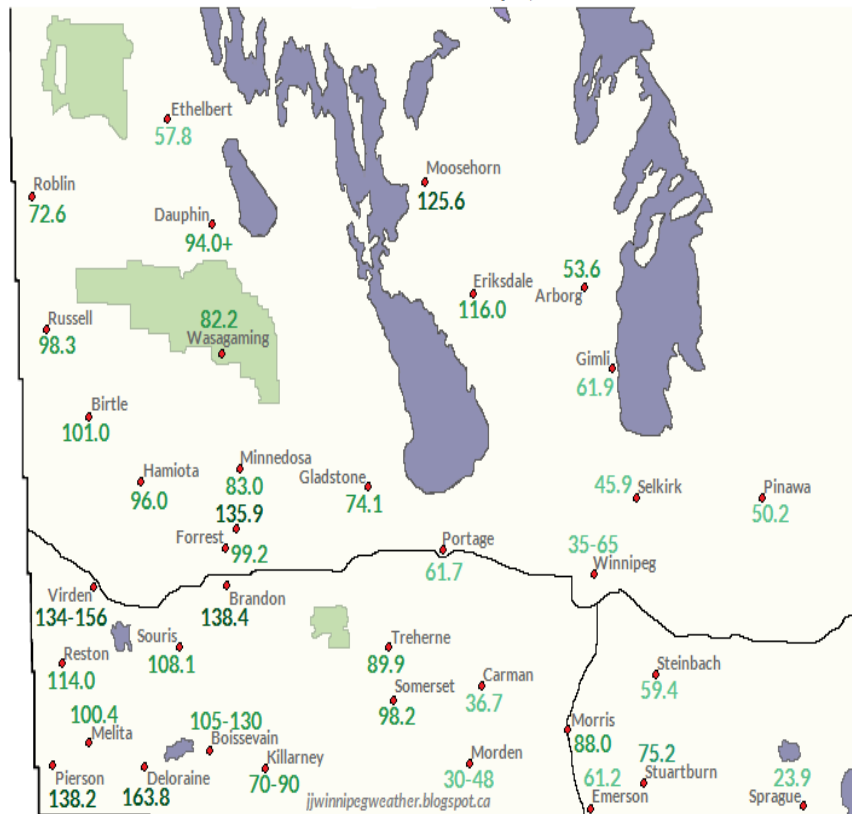


Manitoba Ag-Weather Program Percentage of Normal Accumulated Precipitation

Rainfall Totals June 27 to July 1, 2014

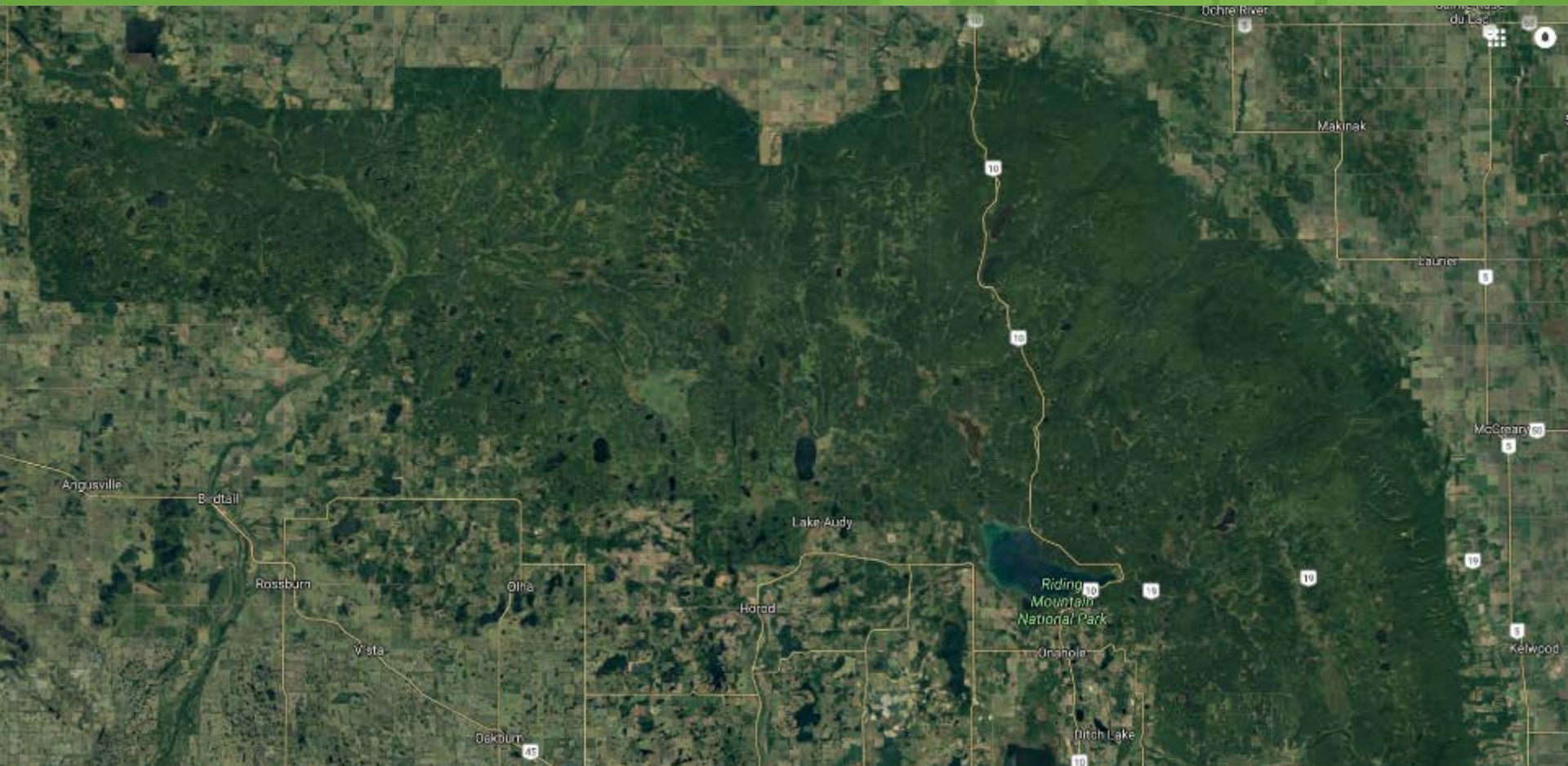
